a chemical that stimulates our nerves






Sensory Organs

Neuron


a type of cell that captures information and moves it to another place





Receptor

Response

an action performed in response to a situation, event, or stimulus

stimulus ⇒ sensory nerve ⇒ spinal cord ⇒ brain ⇒ motor nerve ⇒ response
