Learning Goals

In this task you will be working on:

- CCSS Reading: Analyze and critique a variety of increasingly complex print and non-print literary texts.
- Additional Modes of Communication: Visual Communication

- Cite your sources using a standard citation method as directed by your teacher (e.g. MLA, APA) and include a work cited/reference page.

Task

Write a research paper about a topic that we touched on this year that you would like to know more about. Refer to the list of possible topics or choose one of your own.

SUMMARY:

- **Topic:** Something that we touched on this year that you would like to know more about. Refer to the list of possible topics or choose one of your own.
- **Genre:** Informational writing: The goal of the research paper is to use evidence to educate the reader about the topic.
- Evidence sources: Cite at least five (5) sources for 10 grade using at least three (3) different types of the following works: books, magazine articles, online materials, expert interviews, visual and audio materials, functional documents, and public documents.
- Audience: The reader may have some knowledge about your topic, but it should be explained thoroughly. The tone and language should be academic.
- Products and Rubrics: The research paper should be between 3-5 pages (5-8 paragraphs).
- **Timeline:** Students will have 6 weeks to complete this task.
