

Signing up for Scribe

Sign up (free) ↕

1. Go to www.scribe.com
2. Click on **Sign Up for Free** in the middle of your screen.
3. Sign in using **Google + (DON'T ENTER ALL YOUR INFO - it's much easier to just click the Google + button)**



4. Use your Summit email account (@mysummitps.org) to log in.
 5. When Scribe and Google ask permission to use your information, click **YES**.
 6. If it asks you to upgrade to the "student version," say yes!
 6. Accept the **Terms and Conditions** by scrolling to the bottom of the page and clicking **ACCEPT**.
 7. Click **Install the Scribe TOOLBAR** and follow the directions on the screen to install the bookmarklet in your browser. (You just have to drag and drop the toolbar)
- * If you don't have a bookmarks bar, go to settings → show bookmarks → this will drop the bookmark bar down

Scribe Scavenger Hunt!

1. Go to this website: <http://bit.ly/Z8tCw2>
2. Make sure that the Scribe Toolbar is installed on your Bookmarks Bar. When you click on it, it will load the Toolbar beneath your Bookmarks Bar:



3. Make sure that you are signed in to your Scribe Account: 
4. Read the first four paragraphs of the article, "The MPAA's Silly New Plan to Keep Kids Away From Violent Movies."
5. Using the Scribe Toolbar, change the text color of the first sentence of the article to **PINK**. 
6. Highlight the following sentence in **TURQUOISE**: 
"Instead of tweaking the content standards, the MPAA will use bigger font to describe the adult content and criteria in a film that produced its rating."
7. Put the following sentence in **bold**: 
"They are calling it the 'Check the Box' approach, and it's an awful idea."
8. Highlight the following sentence with your cursor:
"The MPAA's new labels will not stop anyone from seeing movies with adult content; it will only save children the trouble of squinting."
9. Add a comment box in **LAVENDER** to correspond with the sentence you highlighted. 
10. Type the following sentence in the comment box: "This is what the author predicts will happen if the MPAA uses the new labels."
11. Save the page to your Scribe account. 
12. Go to your Scribe library and confirm that the page is saved in your library.
13. When you are finished, go here for the ANSWER KEY to check your annotations!
