## Model United Nations Protocol

## Setup

The room should be arranged in a circle or rectangle so everyone can see each other.

## Roles

**Presenters & Audience** – Half of the class will be presenting their countries, while the other half will serve as an audience. The roles will reverse the next day.

**Audience Responsibilities** – the Audience will take notes on the "Question Asking Template" for each of the countries and will be responsible for asking one question for discussion or about a specific country.

## Logistics

**Introduction** – Each country will be permitted three minutes to introduce themselves, share demographic information of their country, explain the data of their country in 2020, and analyze their findings.

**Clarifying Questions** – Other countries, audience members, or the facilitator can ask questions to more clearly understand the information presented.

**Discussion** – Once all of the countries and data are introduced, the facilitator will ask the first question, "In your country how are you addressing the issue of extreme hunger and poverty? What are the underlying causes of this problem? What are some creative approaches that you believe will help eradicate this problem?"

**Q & A** – Audience members will be able to ask questions.

**Closing Thoughts** – Each country should prepare a thirty second send-off with an action step that they can take to work toward the goal of ending hunger.
